Premarital Covenant

We are committed to God's ways in preparing for our marriage. We agree to abstain from sexual intimacy until we share our marriage vows together. We believe it is God's will for our life and marriage to be sanctified, to be set apart for pure and holy living.

"It is God's will that you be sanctified, that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honorable . . . For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life. Therefore, he who rejects this instruction does not reject man but God, who gives you His Holy Spirit." 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8

We also understand that God does not look at our past failures. Instead, He looks at us as broken people, whom He can make new. With His forgiveness, we can start over again. As we ask God to forgive us, He will see us as a completely new couple.

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

We trust God and honor Him by upholding His boundaries for sexual intimacy and we promise to reserve the gift of physical intimacy only for the context of marriage. We believe that with God's power we will be able to keep this covenant and be greatly blessed by our obedience to Him.
